3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4. REVIEW CONTRACTORS QUALIFICATIONS

The purchasing agent sent out a request for qualifications to approximately 15 contractors. Of the 15 contractors, only four submitted their qualifications. They are Air Temp, All State, Modern Mechanical, and Sav Mor. The city of Bristol/Board of Education has worked with three of the four and there is no reason to believe the fourth is not qualified. They have a great reputation in the market.

There are four scenarios for consideration:

- a. Accept the four contractors and ask for proposals
- b. Determine a methodology to reject one or more firms on qualifications
- c. Having only 4 contractors is unacceptable and redo RFQ
- d. Scrap the RFQ's and not use them but use DAS instead

It is important to be specific of expectations during pre-bid and perform a comprehensive scope review with the engineer.

On a motion by David Hartley and seconded by Cheryl Thibeault it was unanimously voted to go with the four contractors that provided their qualifications and ask for proposals.
